Whereas the Estate of aforesaid has been represented insolvent and commissioners have been appointed to receive and examine the claims of the several creditors thereof according to Law who have reported to Me a List of all the claims, that have been laid before them with the sums allowed on each claim amounting in the whole to the Sum of one hundred seventy two dollars fifteen Cents and eight Mills. And whereas there appear to remain in your hands (after deducting such debts and charges as the Law requires you to pay) a ballance of One hundred and thirty dollars - you are therefore hereby ordered to pay the said ballance to the Creditors named in the List aforesaid in proportion to the sums due them respectively as follows
