

SETTLEMENT OF DAVID WRIGHT (1722-1746)

The Settlement of the Estate of David Wright late of Deerfield in the County of Hampshire Decd is as follows viz— The whole Estate both the Real & Personal & Debts due to the Estate amounts to the Sum of Eleven hundred & Eighty Seven pounds Seven Shillings & four pence of which Six hundred & thirteen pounds is Real Estate & Five hundred Seventy four pounds Seven Shillings & four pence is personal Estate out of which personal estate must be Subducted the Sum of Seven pounds one Shilling & Eight pence debts due from Said Estate, Nineteen pounds Eight shillings the Adms Accy allow'd, fifty Eight Shillings Subducted for Corn overprized & forty pounds an allowance to the widow out of the necessary bedding utensils and Implements of Houshold all which Sums being Subducted there remains the Sum of Five hundred & four pounds nineteen Shillings & Eight pence of the personal Estate of which the widow of the Decd is to have one third being one hundred & Sixty Eight Pounds Six Shillings & Six pence forever. & Submit Wright the only Child of Said Decd is to have all the remainder of the personal Estate being three hundred & thirty Six pounds thirteen Shillings & two pence, and the real Estate of Said Decd amounts to Six hundred & thirteen pounds of which the Said Widow is to have one third during life being Two hundred & four pounds Six Shillings & Eight pence, and Submit Wright The only Daughter of Said Decd is to have the remainder of Said real Estate being four hundred & Eight pounds thirteen Shillings & four pence

At Court of Probates holden at Northampton within for the County of Hampshire of the Second Tuesday of Janry being the 12<sup>th</sup> day of Said Month AnnoDom 1747 P John Stoddard Esq Judge of Said Court the foregoing Settlement of the Estate of David Wright late of Deerfield in Said County Decd is ratified and Confirmed as a Settlement of the Said Estate & Messr Lt Timothy Childs David Field Eleazer Hawks John Catlin Senr & William Arms all freeholders in Deerfield aforeSaid are appointed to make an equal Distribution of the real Estate of said Decd in equal Proportion to the Widow and Daughter according to the above Settlement & the Adms is hereby ordered to pay out the personal Estate according to this Settlement
