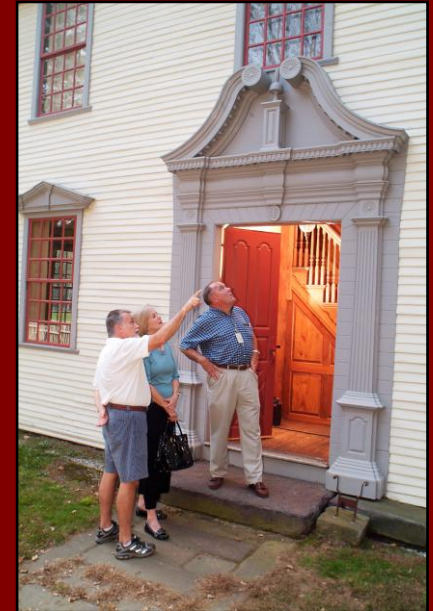

### TEXTILES



The textile collection includes historical clothing and accessories, a variety of needlework, coverlets and quilts.

### FURNITURE



The furniture collection features objects from America's colonial seaports, and New England furniture with an emphasis on the Connecticut River Valley.

### SILVER & METALWARE



The silver and metalware collection is one of the most renowned in the country, with a strong focus on New England church and domestic objects.



### CERAMICS



A wide range of imported and American earthenware, stoneware and porcelain is represented in our collection—with a particular emphasis on Chinese export porcelain and English pottery.

### ARCHITECTURE



Eleven historic houses are available for touring. Also available by request are: the Cowles Barn/Boyden Carriage Collection, Wapping Schoolhouse, and John Wilson Printing Office.

### Cost

A full-day *Tour by Appointment* costs \$125, and includes admission for up to two (2) people for up to six (6) hours - with a break for lunch. Additional visitors can be added for a fee of \$50 each, up to a total of six (6).

A half-day *Tour by Appointment* costs \$75, and includes admission for up to two (2) people for a maximum of three (3) hours. Additional visitors can be added for a fee of \$25 each, up to a total of six (6).
