

SETTLEMENT OF SAMUEL ALLIN (1702-1746)  
HAMPSHIRE Probate Records, Volume VII, p. 350

The Settlement of the Estate of Samuel Allin late of Deerfield in the County of Hampshire Decd Intestate is as follows viz— The whole Estate both Real & Personal & Debts due to the estate amounts to the Sum of Four Thousand Three hundred fifty two pounds Eight Shillings & Seven pence of which Three thousand five hundred fifty Six pounds is Real Estate & Seven hundred ninety Six pounds Eight Shillings, & Seven pence is Personal Estate out of which personal Estate must be Subducted the Sum of Three hundred & Eight pounds Eighteen Shillings & one penny the Debts due from the Estate of the Adms Acc allow'd which being Subducted there remains of the Personal estate the Sum of Four hundred Eighty Seven pounds ten Shillings & six pence of which Hannah Allin widow & Relict of said Decd is to have one third part forever being one hundred Sixty two pounds Ten shillings & two pence, & one third part of the Real Estate during life being Eleven hundred & Eighty five pounds Six Shillings & Eight pence the remainder of the estate both Real & Personal (amounting to the Sum of Two Thousand Six hundred & ninety five pounds Thirteen Shillings & Eight pence) is to be equally divided to & among Caleb Allin Samuel Allin Lamberton Allin & Enoch Allin the Sons of Said Decd & to Sarah Allin Chloe Allin Eunice Allin Hannah Allin Susanna Allin & Mercy Allin the daughters of Said decd Saving that Caleb Allin the Eldest Son is to have a double Share & that the Sons are to have the whole of their Shares out of the Real Estate & a Single Share of Said Estate being Two hundred forty five pounds one Shilling & two pence half penny Caleb Allin is to have the Sum of Four hundred ninety pounds two Shillings five pence all out of Real Estate which is his double Share & Sam Allin Lamberton Allin & Enoch Allin the other Sons are each of them to have the Sum of two hundred forty five pounds one Shilling & two pence half penny out of the Real Estate which makes their Single Shares & Sarah Allin Chloe Allin Eunice Allin Hannah Allin Susanna Allin & Mercy Allin are each of the to have the Sum of Fifty four pounds three Shillings & four pence half penny out of the Personal Estate one hundred ninety pounds Seventeen Shillings & ten pence each out of the Real Estate which Sum makes for their respective Shares

At a Court of Probate holden at Northampton within & for the County of Hampshire on the Second Tuesday of May being the 12<sup>th</sup> day of Said Month Anno Dom 1752 Timothy Dwight Esq Judge of Said Court, the foregoing Settlement of the Estate of Sam Allin late of Deerfield in the County aforesaid Decd Intestate is ratified & is informed as a Settlement of said Estate & the Admx is hereby Order'd to pay out the Personal Estate to the Person's agreeable to the Sums Allotted them in the foregoing Settlement Messr Elijah Williams Esq Capt John Catlin Ensn Joseph Barnard Ensn Mathew Clesson Samuel Childs Junr all freeholders in Said Deerfield are appointed to make a just & Equal Distribution of the Real Estate to the Widow & Children of said Decd in proportion to the Several Sums order'd them in the foregoing Settlement
